

MarkBook® Data Files Transfer for Chromebooks

Changing from MarkBook® for Windows® to Chromebook version at Home

If you can access your computer at school, you can create the files that you need from MarkBook[®] for Windows[®] which may then be imported into MarkBook[®] Cloud version.

This is done using the MarkBook Exchange Export feature found in MarkBook[®] for Windows[®] (MB Exchange -Export button on the Main form). See page 2 in the MarkBook_Class_Exchange.pdf in the Support Section.

The files created in this procedure need to be saved to your Google Drive or a USB stick that can be read by a Chromebook.
