



# MarkBook® Data Files Transfer for Chromebooks

Changing from MarkBook® for Windows® to Chromebook version at Home

---

If you can access your computer at school, you can create the files that you need from MarkBook® for Windows® which may then be imported into MarkBook® Cloud version.

This is done using the **MarkBook Exchange Export feature** found in MarkBook® for Windows® (**MB Exchange -Export** button on the Main form). See page 2 in the **MarkBook\_Class\_Exchange.pdf** in the Support Section.
